Many of these systems were unique to specific locations, often **making** data inaccessible to employees in other offices.

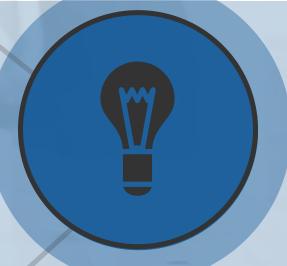
